



WORSHIP CONTINGENCY PLAN FOR INCLEMENT WEATHER

On rare occasions, church services and events may be changed or cancelled due to extremely snowy conditions, loss of electricity, or other emergency situations. When this happens on a Sunday morning, the decision will be made prior to 7:00 am.

SAFETY FIRST

Our number one concern is for the safety of our worshipers and staff. We recognize that there are many factors that determine the safety of driving in inclement weather. Therefore, it is not possible for us to have a “one size fits all” recommendation when it comes to emergency situations and inclement weather. We leave it up to individuals to determine whether they feel safe coming to church considering road conditions and other factors.

WORSHIP CHANGE

If either our Interim Pastor is unable to attend worship due to road conditions, alternate worship services will be offered at 8am and 10am.

WORSHIP CANCELLATION

Worship may be cancelled due to extreme weather conditions or power outages.

HOW TO FIND OUT

We will use several methods to notify the congregation of worship changes or closures, including:

- Posting a message on the home page of our website (stcuthbertoakville.ca).
- Mass email.
- Changing the message on our phone’s answering machine to announce the closure.
- Encouraging “word of mouth” communications. Although we have no official “phone tree” in place, we encourage members and friends to communicate with each other via phone about changes and closures, especially those who may not have online access to the information.
